

Why does Taranaki Base Hospital need to be Redeveloped?

- The buildings erected in the 1970-80's have become outdated
- The new building will allow for modern services such as increased day procedures, which is expected to increase by 11% in the new facility
- The redevelopment will co-locate services which are currently spread over the campus
- An increase of single bedrooms (15% to 47%)
- Ensuites in all patient rooms
- An increase number of smaller multi bedrooms (maximum of 4)
- Air conditioning will add patient comfort

The redevelopment will bring Base Hospital in line with modern practices, and is vital for the future health of the people of Taranaki to 2015 and beyond.

New Entrance

Christchurch based architects Warren and Mahoney, have completed the design for the entrance, incorporating both the existing and the new entrances to the hospital.



The new entrance will use landscaping and signage to draw the public away from the old entrance. The permanent link, new entrance and lobby will be the final part of the new build where the current Stainton Block is. Demolition of the Stainton Block should take place around August 2013 with completion in 4-6 months.

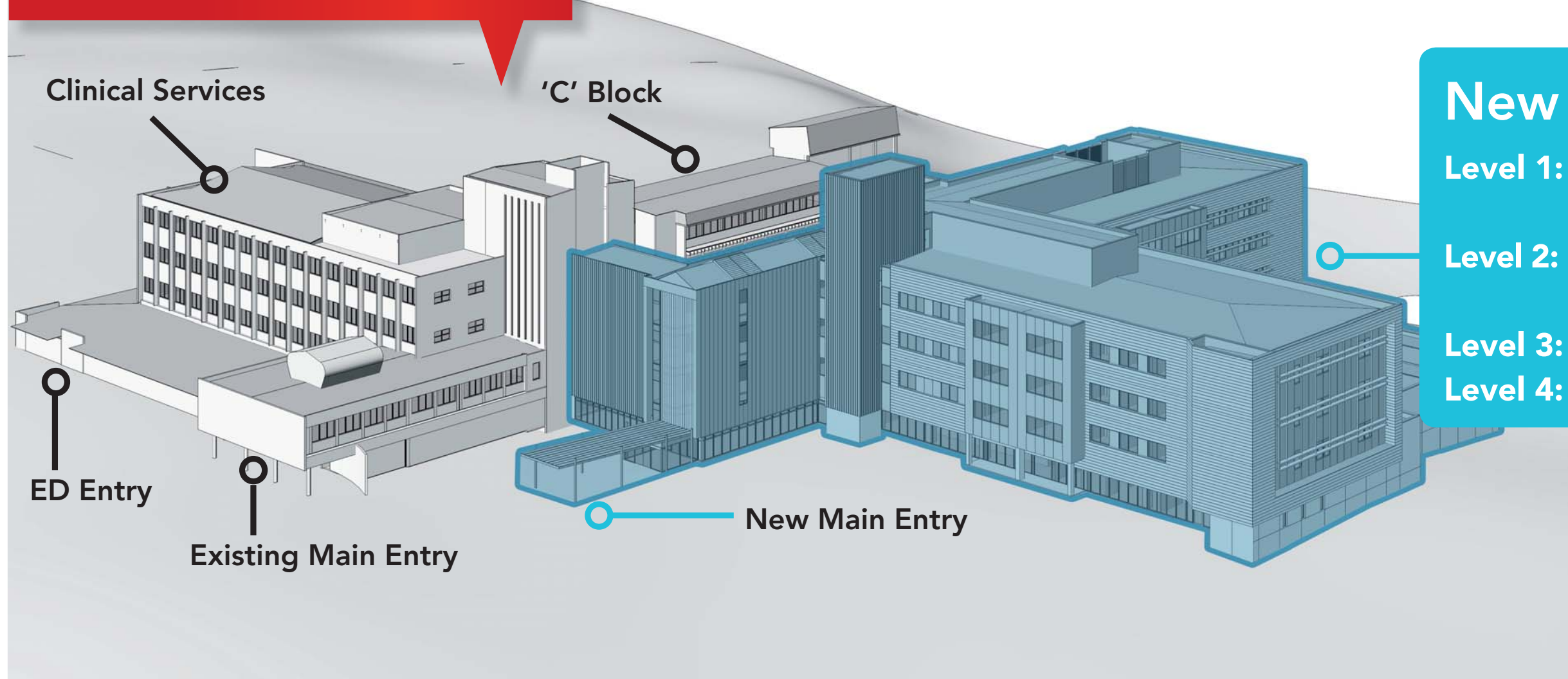

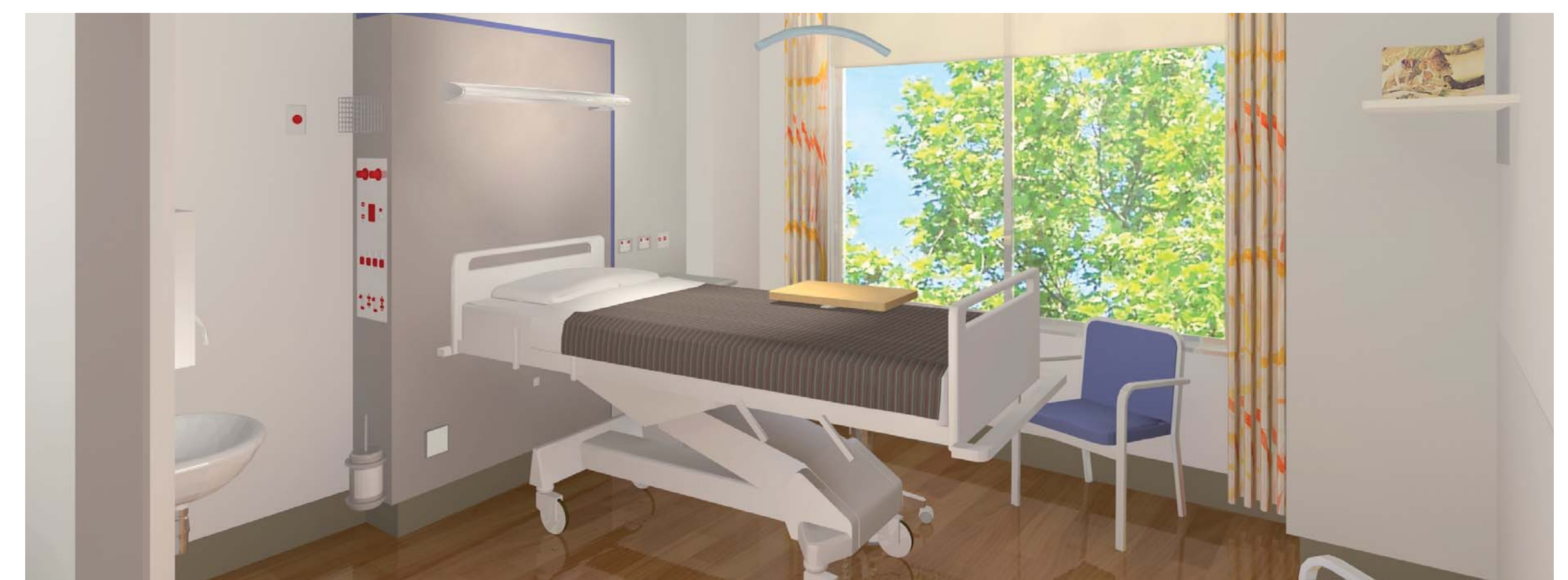
